

EXTRA-CURRICULAR PARTICIPATION POLICY

The primary purpose of this policy is to ensure academic success and provide an avenue for students to develop basic skills to be successful in their future career or as they pursue higher education and training.

Students will not be eligible to participate in extra-curricular activities under the following conditions:

Grades:

1. failing any class with a 65 or below
2. failing two or more classes (regardless of the grade)

Attendance:

1. 5 unexcused tardies
2. 5 unexcused absences
3. 8 combined unexcused tardies or absences
4. After a student has been suspended for 1 week for the above attendance violations, the student will be suspended 1 week for each additional infraction thereafter.

Grades and attendance reports are sent to all faculty, staff and coaches every Monday morning by 10:00 a.m. for review. If a student is ineligible, the student is ineligible to participate in any extra-curricular activities until the following Monday. This policy is based on semesters. It will be enforced as written during semester 1 and absences and tardies will reset at the beginning of semester 2.
